Los Rios Model

- Provides mechanism for updating an Ed Plan between counselors and students
- An iSEP is created by a counselor. When completed an electronic copy is provided to student
- Counselor copy is archived and preserved
- Student can populate their Student Self-Service *My Planner* from electronic copy

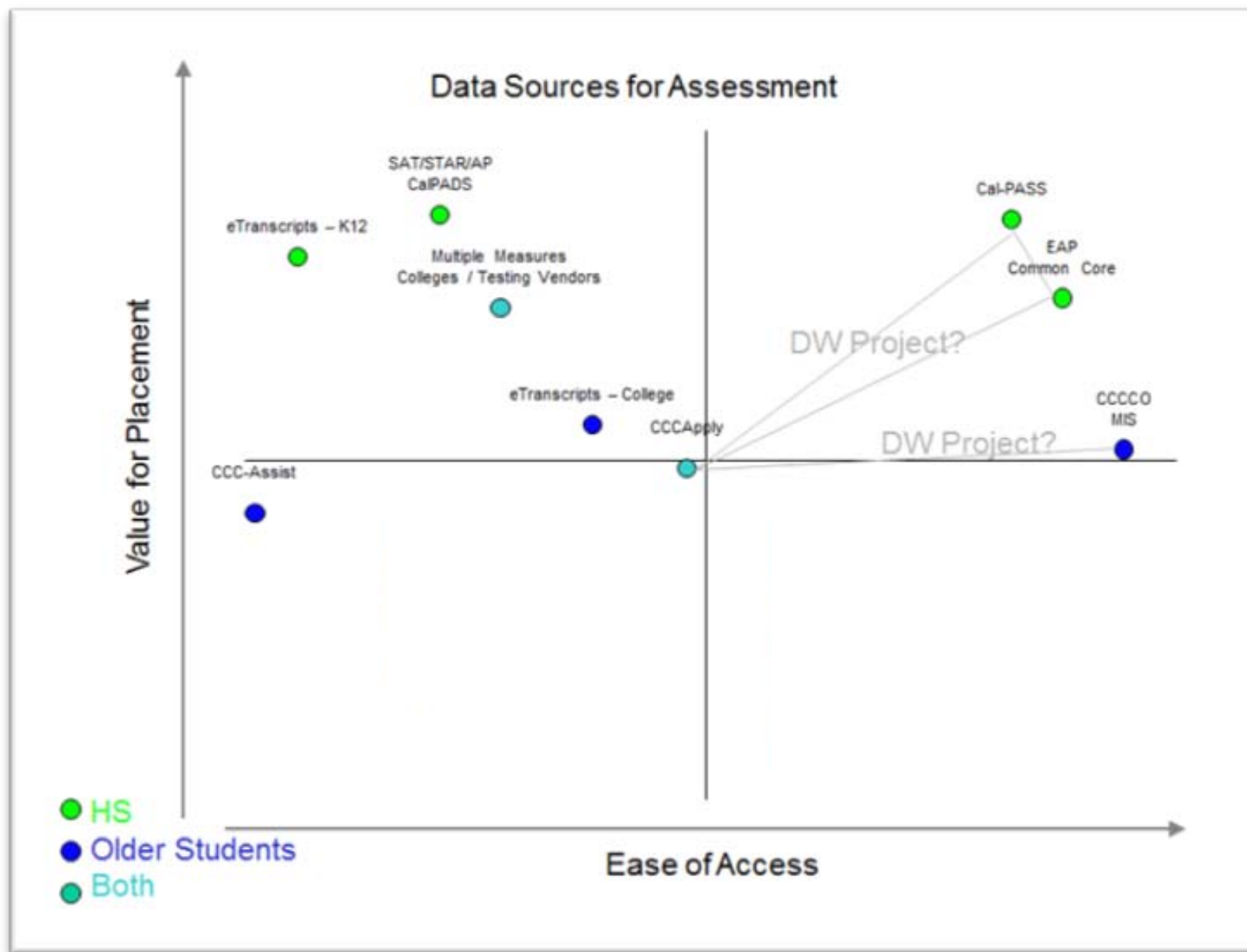
