- Unique for the “California Electronic Transcript Standard”
 - Course level CSU-GE, IGETC
 - Certification for CSU-GE, IGETC, AI
 - Associate Degrees for Transfer (AA-T, AS-T)
 - District-wide Transcripts (delivery support for individual transcripts)
