Problem Statement

One of the Colleges reported that eTranscriptCA was not supporting the upload of a transcript with the IGETC value “5C” in the course detail. Research shows the “5C” eligibility code was added to the IGETC Standards last year and eTranscriptCA was not updated to reflect that change.

Upon further review of the IGETC codes listed as acceptable values within eTranscriptCA, discrepancies were found when compared to the ASSIST database IGETC available codes. Confirmation is needed for which codes should be included as eligible eTranscriptCA values for CSU IGETC and UC IGETC.

Solution Request

Modify ASCII eTranscriptCA transcripts by adding the following IGETC codes to the list of acceptable values. Map new values to XML and EDI to match the other codes. Handle new values the same as the existing values for display, PDF, and print.

Codes currently listed in the data dictionary version 3.0:
