What is CCCTran?

CCC Electronic Transcript System is a statewide Internet-based system for requesting, viewing and securely transmitting standardized electronic transcripts among authorized educational institutions and their trading partners.

- Launched into Production – July 2007
- Currently 10 colleges “Live” (5 CCC; 5 CSU) with 14 other colleges in the process

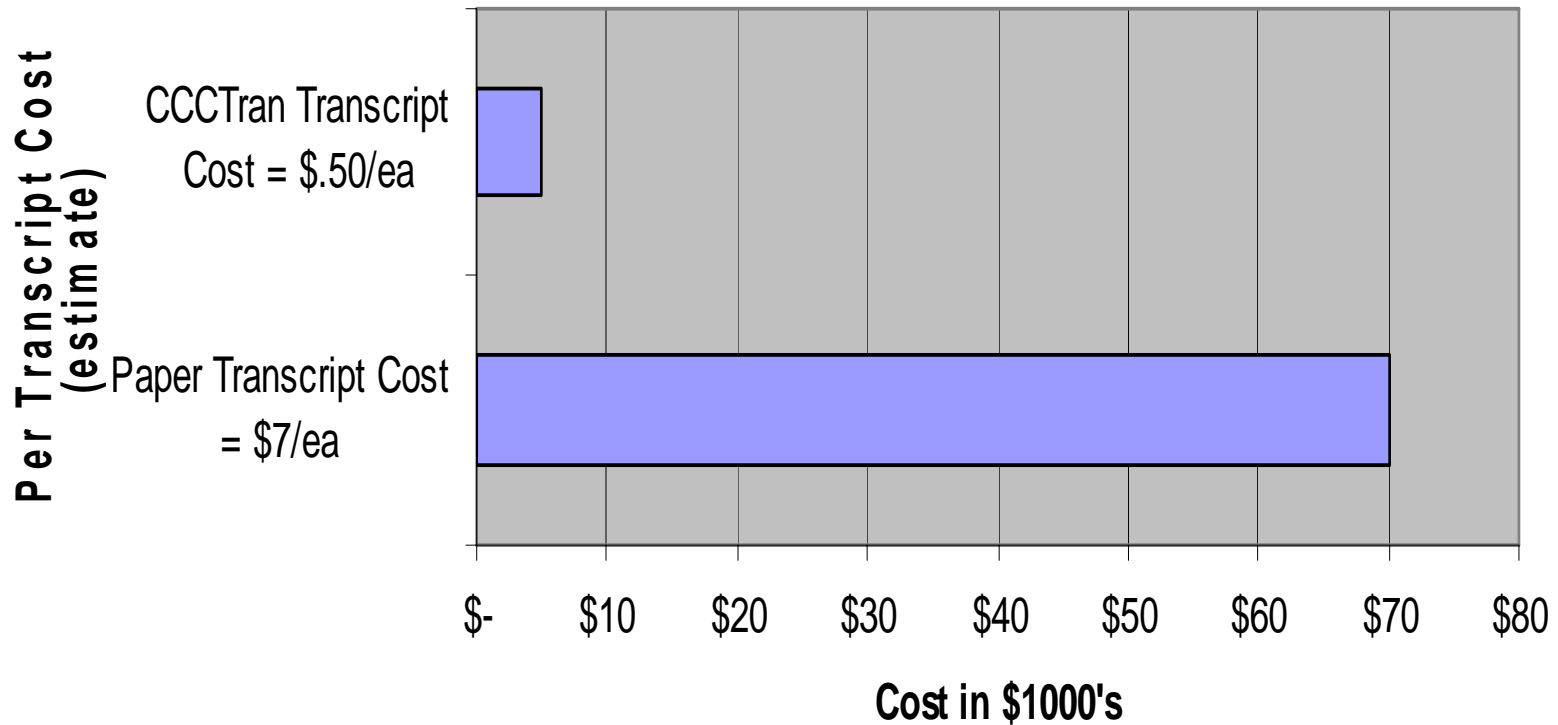

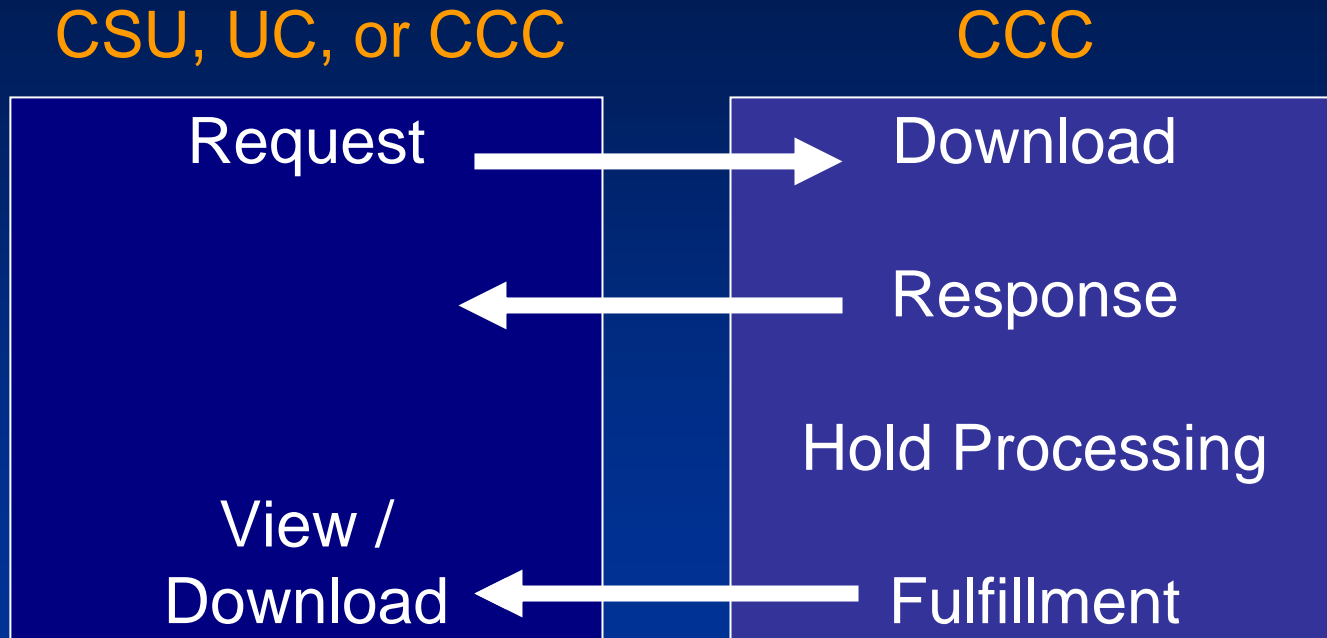
- Save personnel time and reduce expenses

Development

- Phase I
 - Implement District-wide Transcripts
 - Wrapping up phase 1 functionality set aside to go live
- Phase II
 - Import High School Transcripts into CCTran from CA School Information Services (CSIS)
 - Facilitate building student academic profile for planning
 - Accept 3rd party requests from California Colleges, Credentials or National Student Clearinghouse
